How to find us

Leave St. Austell travelling south on the B3273 for approx. 4 miles. Follow our brown tourist signs to the park by **TURNING RIGHT** at the crossroads at the top of the hill towards the Lost Gardens of Heligan and Gorran Haven. We are two miles beyond the Lost Gardens of Heligan.

Do not go into Mevagissey or use satellite navigation systems.
